The <u>23rd Annual Nights of Lights</u> is a month-long celebration featuring beautiful holiday lights, artisan shopping, and weekly festivities on Friday nights along Main Street in downtown Half Moon Bay. *Many shops will be open to 8 p.m. Free parking.*

A winter visit to the Christmas tree farms around Half Moon Bay is a cheerful and fun-filled tradition for many families. With lots spread out along San Mateo Road (Hwy. 92) and Cabrillo Highway (Rt. 1), visitors can get into the holiday spirit while picking out their own Christmas tree. Below is a selection of local tree farms open to visitors. Most have trees starting Thanksgiving weekend but call to confirm.

- **4-C's Christmas Tree Farm** select from a wide array of gorgeous firs and spruces at affordable prices. Choose to chop it down or get a pre-cut tree.
