HALF MOON BAY, CA –OCTOBER 1, 2019 - There is no better place to celebrate the wonders of the fall season than along the <u>Half Moon Bay Coastside</u>. Fondly regarded as the pumpkin capital of the world, this beautiful coastal region, located 45 minutes south of San Francisco, produces more than 3,000 tons of pumpkins every year. Visitors will delight in the area's brilliant orange pick-your-own-pumpkins and scenic backdrop of rich fall colors. The local menus are brimming over with pumpkin-inspired delights such as pumpkin cheese, pumpkin gnocchi, and even pumpkin beer on tap!

- PUMPKIN EVENTS -

12th Annual Hand-Blown Art Glass Pumpkin Patch

Oct. 5-6, 10 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Half Moon Bay Art Glass will transform the grounds of La Nebbia Winery into a glistening glass pumpkin patch featuring the work of glass blower Douglass C. Brown. This artistic installation will feature hundreds of one-of-a-kind glass pumpkins available for purchase, each one personally handcrafted by Brown, who works year-round to create this spectacular display. La Nebbia Winery will be open for guests to partake in wine tasting and to purchase bottles of wine, while bocce ball courts offer fun for everyone. For those who wish to create their own piece of art, HMB Art Glass is offering several classes year around. Classes start as low as \$40 for kids (must be at least six years old). 46th Annual Safeway World Championship Pumpkin Weigh-Off (free!) Oct. 14, 7 a.m. - 11 a.m.

Pumpkin growers gather to compete for the heaviest pumpkin at the annual Safeway World Championship Pumpkin Weigh-Off in the World Pumpkin Capital of Half Moon Bay. In a payby-the-pound system, the winner will take home a hefty \$7 per pound for the champion megapumpkin. Defending Half Moon Bay champion Steve Daletas took home the top prize in 2018 with his 2,170-pound weigh-off champion mega-gourd that obliterated a formidable field of heavyweight contenders. A special \$30,000 bonus mega-prize will be awarded to any grower who breaks the world record (currently 2,624-pounds set in 2016 at a **weigh-off** in Germany). Beauty will share center stage with beefy brawn with a \$1,000 prize awarded to the "most beautiful pumpkin" as judged by the audience based on color, shape, and size. Spread out along Highway 92 (San Mateo Road) and Cabrillo Highway (Rt. 1), visitors will discover pumpkins in a wide variety of colors, shapes, and sizes in a beautiful rural setting. Below is a selection of local pumpkin farms open to visitors:
